	different fields who guide and motivate them on life skills and careers. Students who graduate from high school are also able to attend the Daystar University Leadership program which builds skills for success in college and in the workplace. The goal of the
	program is to educate and graduate young, responsible and competent adults who will positively influence their communities. In
	2023, the program supported 23 students through their year of education and saw 5 graduate from their college studies.

	women living in extreme poverty. Pangea works with groups of women known as cooperatives and provides training in leadership,
	human rights, basic business skills and bookkeeping, personal development, nutrition, hygiene and reproductive health. The
	majority of the members are small scale traders and farmers engaged in different businesses. In 2023, Pangea was able to train
	17 women to become trainers, helping us to expand our reach through locally empowered women in each of the areas we
	currently work. With this increased capacity, Pangea provided workshops to 370 women in life and business skills throughout the
	year and provided business mentorship for 428 women already in the network, along with revolving funds for small business
	growth. Pangea served a total of 798 women through these efforts in 2023.

	necessary to get them successfully to and through college and into the workplace. This is a year-long program that starts with a
	summer intensive conference and followed by monthly meetings. During 2023, the program was delivered in-person and virtual
	monthly meetings. The program had 32 participants participating from January - April and a new cohort of 28 starting in June.

accountant, and by Pangea HQ staff and board. Monthly requisitions for funding are received from the Kenya team, per the approved
budget for the year, and once approved, those monthly funds are wired to cover the month's program and administrative expenses. A
monthly review is conducted by the accountant in the region, reviewing receipts and expenses against the budget and sends an actual
expenditure report, along with bank statements to the U.S. HQ, which are then reviewed. Also, per Kenyan law, the Kenyan books are
audited annually by an independent auditor. For women's cooperatives in Kenya that are receiving revolving funds, program staff conduct
monthly monitoring of all active women's cooperatives and review financial statements, along with random business site visits. Pangea HQ
staff visit the Kenya office on an annual basis for site and cooperative visits with staff. The team also reviews all policies and procedures
and conducts performance reviews annually. Program investments of \$30,032 are funds that have been given to cooperatives after their
six-month training is completed. These funds are disbursed as revolving funds for women to start and grow businesses and increase income
levels and overall quality of life.
